Fiat 500 Front Grille Lettering

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1. Before you begin with the application process you need to ensure the front grille is clean of any acrylic pen or dirt. We recommend you use an alcohol spray and cloth or jet wash. Failure to properly clean the application surface will result in the 3M tape not sticking. Please follow this instruction carefully as returns are not accepted in this case.



Step 2. Once your grille is clean, lay out your letters in front of you with the smooth/shiny surface facing upward in the correct order.

Step 3. With the smooth/shiny surface upwards, apply small sections of tape to match where it may be positioned on your grille. Please estimate where the tape needs to be placed up against your grille before applying the tape. This may be tricky so take time to ensure you know where the lettering will be positioned before peeling the tape.




Tip: use masking tape to mark the temporary positioning.

Step 4. Peel red coating off each piece of 3M tape, but only do this for one letter at a time. If it is relatively cold out, try and warm up the tape by placing the letter in-between your hands to ensure it sticks well.

Step 5. Once all the top layers have been removed, line up the letter to the grille and press the letter on once you're satisfied with its placement. Apply pressure to the letter for around 15 seconds.

Step 6. Make sure you follow steps 2-5 for the remaining letters.
